Caring: As a result of the learning experiences in the course, you will become more competent in your ability to create better learning opportunities and outcomes for learners.

Ethical: As a result of the learning experiences in the course, you will become more competent in your ability to remove the barriers that prevent some learners from learning and engaging in the curriculum. Participants will consider the needs of all students regardless of ability, race, and linguistic background when planning instruction.
